## DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Footloose has its roots in the 1984 film of the same name. The story of Footloose was loosely based on events that took place in the small community of Elmore City, Oklahoma in 1981, where an 88 year old ban on public dancing was repealed after a challenge by students in the senior class at the local high school. The history making prom that followed that policy change was national news.

I love the story Dean Pitchford told in the 1984 movie. It's a story of tragedy, grief and a community so scared that they chose to make illegal anything associated with the deaths of their children. Reverend Moore leads that charge, grieving for his own son, he focuses on saving his community from any future tragedy, which of course is an impossible task. He chooses to teach fear and blame and doesn't lean into the love and comfort his faith and his community could have offered one another. Under this weight, his family is fracturing and as each of them grieve separately, they pull further and further apart.

Ren comes in as the outsider, also dealing with feelings of inexplicable loss, and asks the questions the town has been afraid to ask. He sees them shut out the world and knows that never works. He doesn't want to have to cope with his sadness either but he sees very clearly that hiding from your pain is never the answer.



## DIRECTOR'S NOTE (continued)

"Footloose is actually the story of a man who's lost his son, a boy who's lost his father, and how those two help each other to heal" Dean Pitchford.

The advice Dean Pitchford gives in his Author's Note is poignant. We have discussed this in our rehearsals! He suggested that we substitute the word "dance" with the word..."forgive". We have done this as we tell this story. Shouting "Let's FORGIVE!" at Prom might not be as cool as "Let's DANCE!" but you get the sentiment.

I am so proud of these young people. They have learned so much about life in portraying this story. I hope it is a time in their life they remember with love! Now - LET'S DANCE!

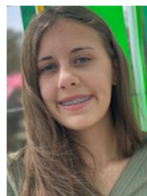
**MYLEE HEISER** – The Zig is my happy place. I love how everyone is always encouraging everyone else. And I love performing with my family – go Lola!
